Investigation and Research on the Impact of New Coronary Pneumonia on the Ideological and Political Status of College Students

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Abstract: Through investigations, it was found that the new crown pneumonia epidemic has had a greater impact on the ideological and political status of college students. The positive influences are: young college students' patriotism enthusiasm is high, their sense of responsibility and responsibility are improved, and their recognition of the superiority of the socialist system with Chinese characteristics is significantly enhanced. Negative effects are as follows: the effect of online teaching is difficult to guarantee, and the development of practical activities is restricted, which will adversely affect the physical and mental health of college students. From the aspects of strengthening Internet + ideological and political education, loving the party and loving socialism education, and college students' physical and mental health education, countermeasures and suggestions for strengthening college students' ideological and political education during the epidemic have been put forward.

1. Introduction

Since the beginning of 2020, the new crown pneumonia epidemic has broken out in most provinces across the country, with tens of thousands of infections and thousands of deaths in a short period of time. The severe epidemic has caused college students to study at home for a long time. Does the epidemic affect the ideological and political status of college students? What impact did it have? This online survey A total of 435 participants submitted the questionnaire. In addition, we have also conducted online interviews and exchanges with more than 100 students through QQ, WeChat, etc., so that we have a clear understanding and grasp of the students' ideo.

2. Analysis of the Survey Results of the I deological and Political Status of College Students during the Epidemic Logical.

This questionnaire consists of multiple choice questions and open-ended questions. The question of the investigation involves the basic information of the participants (gender, grade and major), the policies and countermeasures proposed by the Party Central Committee in the prevention and control of the epidemic, the ways and methods for individuals to strengthen self-prevention and control, and what do you think are the advantages of the Chinese system in the fight against the epidemic? , What is your biggest feeling in the prevention and control of this epidemic? Participating in the online survey involves students from 15 majors including college nursing, pharmacy, construction engineering technology, hotel management, acupuncture and massage technology, traditional Chinese medicine and pharmaceutical technology, traditional Chinese medicine, and computer application technology. Among them, 187 are males (accounting for 42.99). %) and 248 girls (57.01%).

When investigating the countermeasures taken by the Party Central Committee in the prevention and control of the epidemic, 37% of the people said they were quite clear, 48% said they were basically clear, and only 11% said they were not very clear. When investigating the development of the new crown pneumonia epidemic, more than 86% of students said that they must read relevant news every day. In answering the open-ended question "What is your biggest feeling in the prevention and control of this epidemic?" The more common expressions students answered are: proud of being a Chinese (37.6); praise the strong and correct leadership of the Party Central Committee (25.4%); was moved by the retrograde white angel (23.6%), others (13.4%), etc.

It can be seen from this survey that the impact of the new crown pneumonia epidemic on the ideological and political status of college students is considerable and cannot be underestimated. During the epidemic, students' interest in paying attention to news and current affairs has increased significantly, and their attention to the Party's and national lines, principles and policies has also greatly increased, their patriotism has been enthusiasm, and their recognition of the socialist system with Chinese characteristics has been further enhanced. For firmness. In a sense, this epidemic can be called a spiritual baptism that has a profound impact on young college students.[1]

3. The P ositive I mpact of the E pidemic on the I deological and P olitical S tatus of C ollege Students

3.1 The Patriotism Enthusiasm of Young College Students is Unprecedentedly High.

Patriotism is the spiritual driving force that encourages the people of all ethnic groups in our country to continue to improve, and it is the core of the Chinese national spirit. Young college students are the hope of the nation and the future of the motherland. They are also the builders and successors of my country's socialist cause. Patriotism and the aspiration to serve the country are important factors that promote their growth and talent. The first hope that General Secretary Xi Jinping put forward to young students at the Peking University teacher-student symposium in 2018 is to be patriotic, loyal to the motherland and to the people.^[2]

3.2 The Se nse of R esponsibility a nd R esponsibility of C ollege S tudents H as I mproved Significantly.

The epidemic is the order, and prevention and control are the responsibility. In this epidemic, college students actively responded to the call of the party and the state, consciously implemented home isolation, did not gather for dinner, did not go out, and did not visit relatives and friends. Since the outbreak of the epidemic, none of the more than 10,000 students in the college has developed symptoms of infection.

3.3 College S tudents' R ecognition of t he Superiority of t he So cialist System with C hinese Characteristics Has Increased Significantly.

China's fight against the epidemic has achieved major victories in a short period of time, and the

advantages of the socialist system with Chinese characteristics in concentrating its efforts on major issues have been fully highlighted. China's strong comprehensive national strength, strong social mobilization capabilities, and the nation's sense of responsibility for the rise and fall of the world are all living, visible and comprehensible vivid cases. College students can empathize with each other and feel a sense of national pride.^[3]

4. The Negative Impact of the Epidemic on the Ideological and Political Education of College Students

4.1 Classroom L earning is C hanged from Offline to O nline, and the L earning E ffect is Difficult to Guarantee.

Take the ideological and political theory class as an example. From the answers submitted by the survey, it can be seen that the patriotic enthusiasm of the college students is undoubtedly very high, and I believe that the Chinese people can overcome the virus with one heart. However, the frequency of Internet buzzwords in expressions is relatively high, and the ideological judgments in the ideological and political theory textbooks are not clearly reflected. Affected by the epidemic, universities have become the latest batch to start school. As a result, most of the courses are taught online, and some are even taught online throughout the course.

4.2 The Normal Development of Practical Activities is Restricted.

During the epidemic, large-scale public gatherings were basically cancelled in accordance with the requirements of documents at all levels of provinces, cities and schools. Sports events, campus activities, off-campus practices, etc. will be suspended or adjusted to be conducted online. During the epidemic, social practice activities could not be carried out normally, which affected the effectiveness of teaching to a certain extent.^[4]

4.3 The E pidemic H as a C ertain N egative I mpact on t he Physical and M ental H ealth of College Students.

In the survey of college students during the epidemic, it was found that more than half of the students reported that during the epidemic, their daily physical exercise time was less than one hour, and their sleep time was less than 8 hours. Late going to bed and late waking up was the normal state of study and life during the epidemic. Routine sports and competitions such as morning exercises and sports meets in some colleges and universities have been cancelled, and various indicators reflecting the physical fitness of college students have dropped significantly. The psychological survey conducted on the students in the college showed that about 8% of the students had negative emotions such as anxiety, and most of them were graduates. Compared with junior college students, students who will graduate in grades face problems such as possible delays in graduation and difficulties in finding jobs. Vocabulary such as diagnoses, new additions, and deaths frequently appearing in the news will cause people to feel nervous, anxious, and panic.^[5] The apparent increase in the number of students faced by psychological counseling departments in various universities also shows that the epidemic has caused some problems for the mental health of college students.
