Discussion on the Integration of Curriculum Ideological and Political Education into Higher Vocational English Teaching

Teachers should continue to innovate teaching forms so that students can carry out their own learning activities in a variety of forms, and some teachers have more traditional teaching thinking in the teaching activities of higher vocational English ^[7]. 3.3. There are Few Locales and Lack of Practical Operation Opportunities

4.1. Explore the Teaching Situation of the Integration of English Teaching and Ideological and Political Education

Since the English courses of vocational colleges are usually based on language teaching, but different languages also contain different ideological systems, and these ideas usually express corresponding values, some may be beneficial to our development, and some are unfavorable^[9]. In this teaching context, English teachers in vocational colleges can guide students to take on their own responsibilities and missions in their own lives, and have a sense of collective honor ^[10]. In addition, in the process of assigning homework, teachers should also expand the scope of homework, not only limited to course materials, but also add some relevant content of curriculum ideology and politics, so as to continuously improve students' personal ideological and moral character.

4.3. Make Use of the Advantages of the Internet to Expand Knowledge and Deepen Ideological and Moral Education

In the context of today's information age, English teachers in vocational colleges should also make full use of the Internet teaching environment, enrich today's teaching resources and teaching content, constantly broaden students' knowledge horizons, and present the knowledge system of different cultures to students, so that students can also understand the collision between different ideas. Teachers can also let students make full use of network resources to carry out dubbing activities, and teachers can let students conduct English dubbing activities for the introduction videos of tourist attractions such as the Great Wall^[11]. This can also enrich students' learning forms and improve students' practicality in English courses. In such a process of English practice, students can also deepen their understanding of the Great Wall, so as to continuously deepen the work of ideological and moral education.

5. Conclusions
