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Research on the Inheritance and Development of Bian Embroidery in the Context of Regional Characteristics Development

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Abstract: Bian embroidery, originated from the Northern Song Dynasty, one of the traditional Chinese embroidery crafts, is the representative embroidery of Kaifeng area and even the whole Central Plains. The art form of combining Chinese traditional painting and calligraphy with embroidery has an important influence in the history of Chinese embroidery. This original way of using embroidery instead of painting has become an integral part of the development history of Chinese embroidery. With the demise of the Northern Song Dynasty, Bian embroidery has gradually declined, and there are many problems in the inheritance of Bian embroidery, such as the lack of professional embroiderers, single type of works, serious reproduction of products, serious aging of inheritors, etc., which need to be protected and inherited. This paper explores innovative inheritance and development methods based on the development of regional characteristics, provides new ideas for the inheritance and development of Bian embroidery, drives the development of local cultural industry and further promotes regional economic prosperity.

1. Introduction

Bian embroidery is an embroidery craft originated in Kaifeng, Henan Province during the Song Dynasty. As the capital of Northern Song Dynasty, Kaifeng was also called Bianjing at that time, so people called Kaifeng embroidery as "court embroidery" at that time as "Bian embroidery". Although it is not as famous as other four famous embroideries such as Cantonese embroidery, Hunan embroidery, Su embroidery and Shu embroidery, Bian embroidery has its own unique style and regional characteristics. Bian embroidery is one of the most important traditional cultures in China. It was named the fifth most traditional embroidery after the other four famous embroideries in 1982, and was listed in the national intangible cultural heritage list in 2008. However, with the leap development of the industry, the inheritance and development of Bian embroidery is not optimistic, and the development and inheritance of Bian embroidery is hindered by various factors, so it is not only urgent but also necessary to study and discuss the inheritance and development of Bian embroidery in the context of the development of regional characteristics.

2. Overview of Bian embroidery development

During the Northern Song Dynasty, the social economy developed rapidly and the culture and art flourished for a while. As the historical origin of Bian embroidery, the embroidery craft of Song Dynasty has outstanding artistic attainments and brilliant historical achievements. There is a poem in praise of Song Dynasty embroidery: "The flowers and birds in the embroidery shed are new at the time, and the living color and fragrance can capture the truth. In recent times, there is no good sketching hand, but the painting of Xichuan is a needle god." [2] This shows the high artistic level of embroidery in Song Dynasty and its popularity in the society at that time. During the Northern Song Dynasty, there were a large number of artisans who specialized in embroidery, and they innovated on the basis of traditional embroidery methods to make the embroidery effect more colorful. The literati and scholars of Song Dynasty praised Bian embroidery, and the traces of embroidery can be seen everywhere in the court dress, furniture decoration and folk life, so it can be seen that the art of embroidery reached a period of great development at that time. In 1127 A.D., when the Northern Song Dynasty collapsed, a large number of people were forced to move south, and the embroidery in Suzhou and Hangzhou borrowed the embroidery method of Bian, and the embroidery in the Southern Song Dynasty still continued the style of Bian. After the demise of Northern Song Dynasty, the development of Bian embroidery is not as good as before. In the Ming and Qing Dynasty, although Bian embroidery develops with many names and styles, the development of Bian embroidery is hindered by the social environment at that time, and the innovation, sales and production are not as good as before.

After the founding of New China in 1949, the development of Bian embroidery ushered in the spring again. Under the active response of people and strong support of government, Bian Embroidery Art Factory was established in Kaifeng in 1958, and the embroiderers excavated and innovated the traditional Bian embroidery skills, which made a new breakthrough and innovation in Bian embroidery art. At that time, in order to celebrate the tenth anniversary of the founding of New China, Kaifeng Bian Embroidery Art Factory gathered all embroiderers and spent one and a half years to finish the imitation ancient painting embroidery "Qingming Shanghe Tu" as a gift, which was highly appreciated by people. Later on, it embroidered "Hairpin Lady", "Han Xizai Night Banquet", "Five Bulls" and other imitations of ancient paintings as national gifts to friendly countries.

3. The significance of inheriting and developing Bian embroidery

3.1. Bian embroidery promotes the development of regional characteristics

The promotion and development of Bian embroidery has an important significance of regional characteristics, which cannot be developed without the inherent cultural capital of the region. The art of Bian embroidery originates from the Central Plains, which is not only the representative of the creativity and wisdom of ancient people, but also the profound embodiment of Chinese culture. It can assist and serve the local development and bring economic and cultural value to the region. Develop Bian embroidery related industries to create regional characteristics and form city cultural business cards. Develop Bian embroidery related industries, such as combining cultural industry with tourism, developing cultural tourism with Bian embroidery as the highlight, and developing innovative Bian embroidery peripheral products, cultural and creative products, etc. The development of this traditional cultural industry will attract a lot of tourists to experience the charm of Bian embroidery. 3.3. Historical value and cultural connotation of Bian embroidery

is a new mode of promoting and inheriting intangible cultural heritage, spreading Xuanbian embroidery by live broadcast and bringing goods of Bian embroidery works and Bian embroidery peripheral products. From the perspective of innovation and development, the network can effectively collect public opinions, provide suggestions for the development of Bian embroidery, and set up new directions for the innovative design of Bian embroidery, which will help to protect and inherit Bian embroidery more effectively with targeted improvement and innovation.

5. Thinking about the inheritance and development of Bian embroidery

In the past, Bian embroidery was mostly used in furniture, clothing and decorative paintings, but nowadays people seldom wear embroidered clothing, and there are few embroidered screens, hanging curtains, decorative paintings and other items with embroidery at home. For the above problems, the application scope of Bian embroidery should be expanded, so that Bian embroidery can be integrated with contemporary daily necessities, and nowadays cross-stitch is popular all over the country, such as card bag, key chain, cushion, etc., with various forms and rich contents, and at the same time, you can do embroidery by yourself, and enjoy the art of embroidery and bring the joy of embroidery at the same time. Kaifeng Bian embroidery should also learn from this, and develop different kinds of artworks [4]. At the same time of innovation, we should pay attention to keep the traditional "flavor", explore the balance of old and new, keep the original characteristics, push out the new, take the essence and remove the dregs, keep the tradition, inject new life, give full play to its advantages, so that Bian embroidery can be better inherited and developed.

6. Conclusion

As the cultural card of Central Plains, Bian embroidery has high artistic value and historical and cultural value, inheritance and development of Bian embroidery can promote the development of regional characteristics and help local economy prosperity. This paper puts forward a series of strategies for the inheritance and development of Bian embroidery, and it is believed that through joint efforts, Bian embroidery can seize the development opportunity to shine and go to glory step by step.

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
